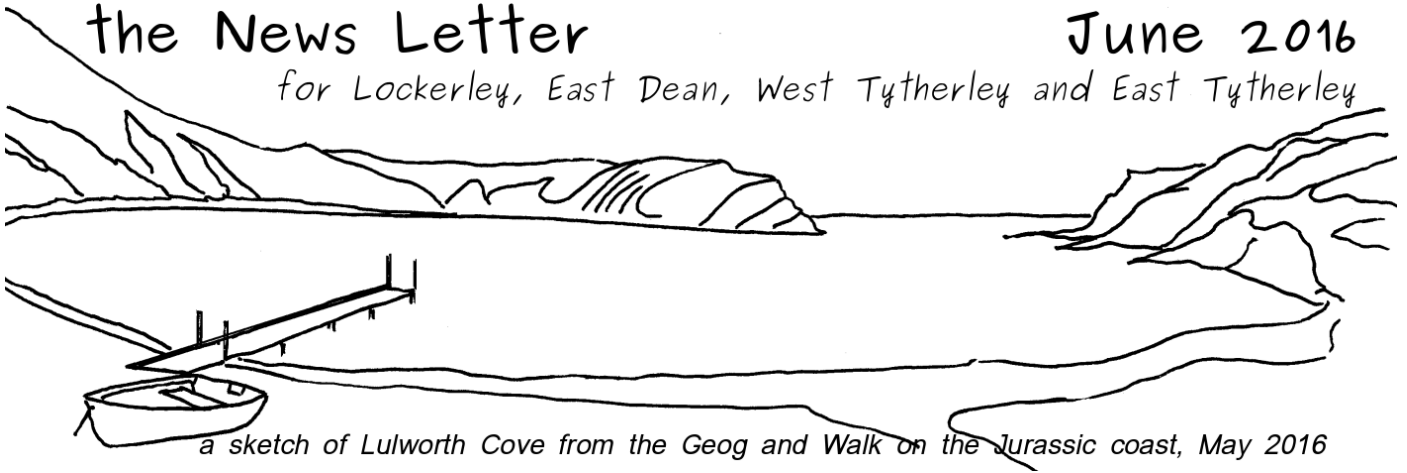

Legacy 110 Project.

Friday 1st July 2016 is the Centenary of the first day of the Battle of the Somme fought during World War One. The Battle was to become the significant Battle of the war and one of the worst in military history. At the end of the first day 19,246 British and commonwealth soldiers were dead on the Battlefield, by the end of the Battle on 1st November 1916 over 125,000 British and commonwealth soldiers had lost their lives including a number of young men from Lockerley.

The Legacy 110 project is a national schools project to engage local communities in remembering the First World War. As part of the project two students from Test Valley School are organising a commemoration of the Battle of the Somme on 1st July 2016, the centenary of the first day of the Battle, and invite the local community to join them.

If you would like to take part in remembering those who gave their lives during the Battle you are invited to place a special poppy in a designated area on Butts Green, during the

day of 1st July from 07:30 when the Battle commenced. Poppies will be available on the Green. For further information please contact: allsoppa@tvs.hants.sch.uk
