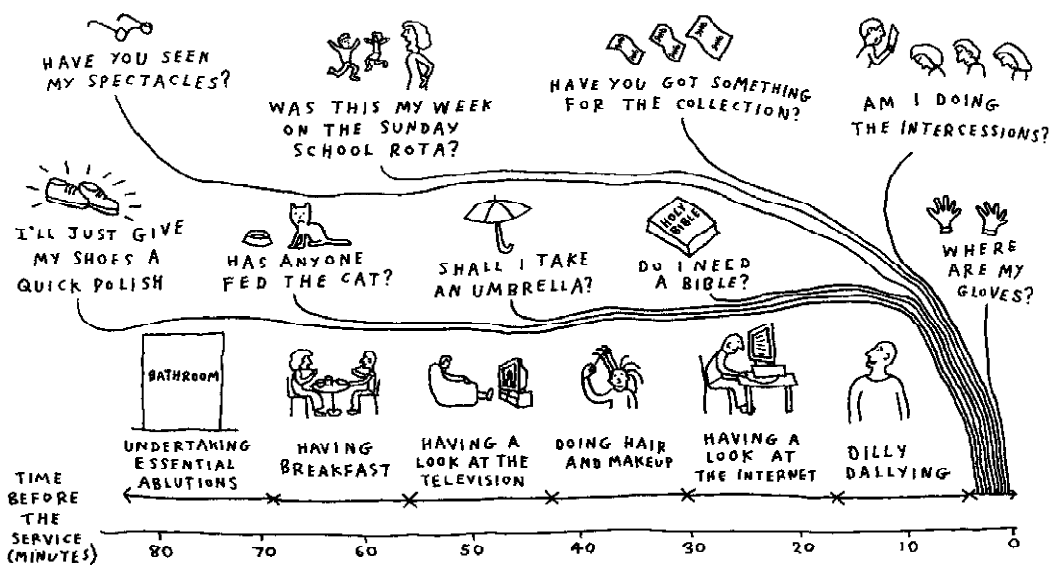
United Benefice of Lockerley, East Dean, East Tytherley and West Tytherley
