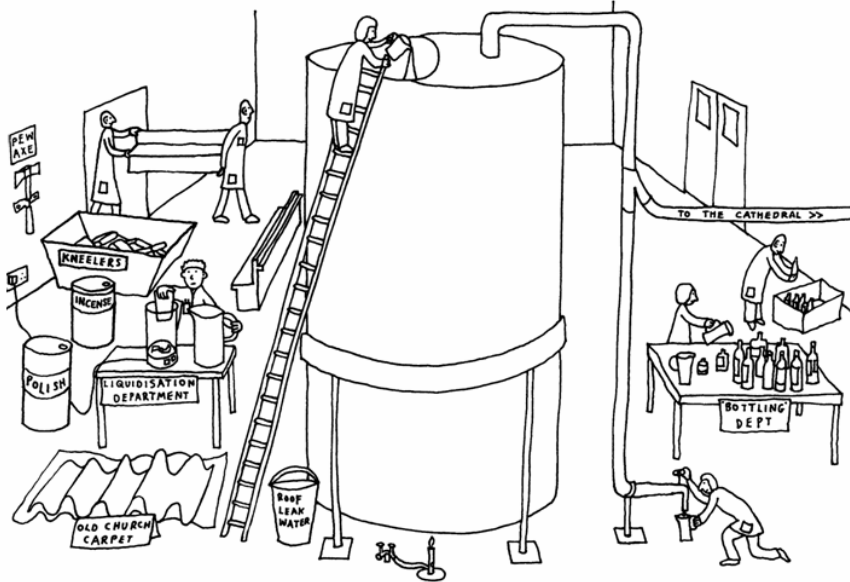

United Benefice of Lockerley, East Dean, East Tytherley and West Tytherley

The Summer is definitely here, although as I write this it is raining! The 15th of July is St Swithun's Day. Swithun was a humble man appointed Bishop of Winchester in 852, who died in July 862. When dying, he asked to be buried outside the church in a place where he would be trodden by the feet of passers-by and receive raindrops from the eaves. However, when a new cathedral was being built, Ethelwold, the new bishop, decided to move Swithun's remains into a shrine in the cathedral, despite dire warnings that to move the bones would bring about terrible storms. He was duly translated on 15th of July 971 and, though many cures were claimed and other miracles observed, it apparently rained for forty days as forecast. Thus the feast day of St Swithun became synonymous with long, summer storms, rather than as an occasion for celebrating Christian simplicity and holiness.
