OPAL

OPAL stands for the Older People's Area Link, and is a new venture run by Age Concern in joint partnership with Hampshire County Council and Hampshire Voluntary Care Groups Advisory Service. It came into being to plug the gaps in service provision and to make sure that everyone can access the services that they need.

All requests for help are directed to AGE CONCERN Hampshire's FREE Information Help Line by ringing 0800 328 7154. All calls will be dealt with in confidence. The inquiry will be dealt with in two ways. If general information is needed, Age Concern Hampshire will provide it. If a visit is needed, then two volunteers from your local Village Care Group who have been specially trained as OPAL volunteers, will visit.

So, if you have any questions about your personal finances, medical services, benefits such as pension credits for which you might be eligible, or are new to the area, feeling isolated and lonely wishing to meet people, finding it difficult to cope or wanting access to local groups or other organisations, ring the help line and you will be linked to the right service.

If you find that you want to join a local group or organisation, but would like to be supported for the first few times that you attend, then the OPAL volunteers can help by coming with you.

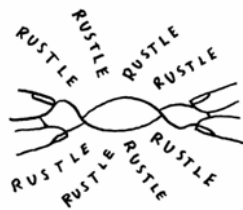
