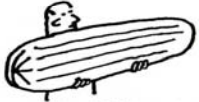

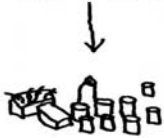

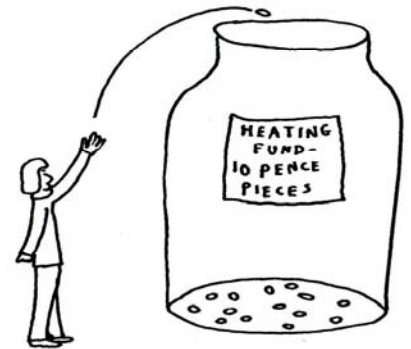

September sees the start of our Harvest Services (and suppers – East Tytherley's on Friday 26th). This year for Harvest we will again be collecting non-perishable foodstuffs for Damascus House in Salisbury (housing for young people who would otherwise be homeless) and SCRATCH (who work to relieve the effects of poverty for families and individuals with needs recognised by approved referral agencies in Southampton and surrounding area) as well as cash for South Rwenzori (sponsoring orphans in school; £50 equals school for one for a year).
