Hampshire Community Innovations Teams are part of a County wide service unique to Hampshire County Council. The teams combine the skills of social care, health and voluntary sector professionals, working in partnership to promote better health and wellbeing for older people. This service is specifically aimed at people aged 55+ who are at risk of losing their independence but do not yet meet the criteria for support from Hampshire County Council's Adult Services Department. The Romsey Community Innovations Team has a Social Worker, Occupational Therapist, Nurse and Support Worker who will help you review your situation and offer you information, advice and support that can enable you to maintain your independence and get back out into your local community. We work alongside you until you are ready to take control of the things that matter to you. 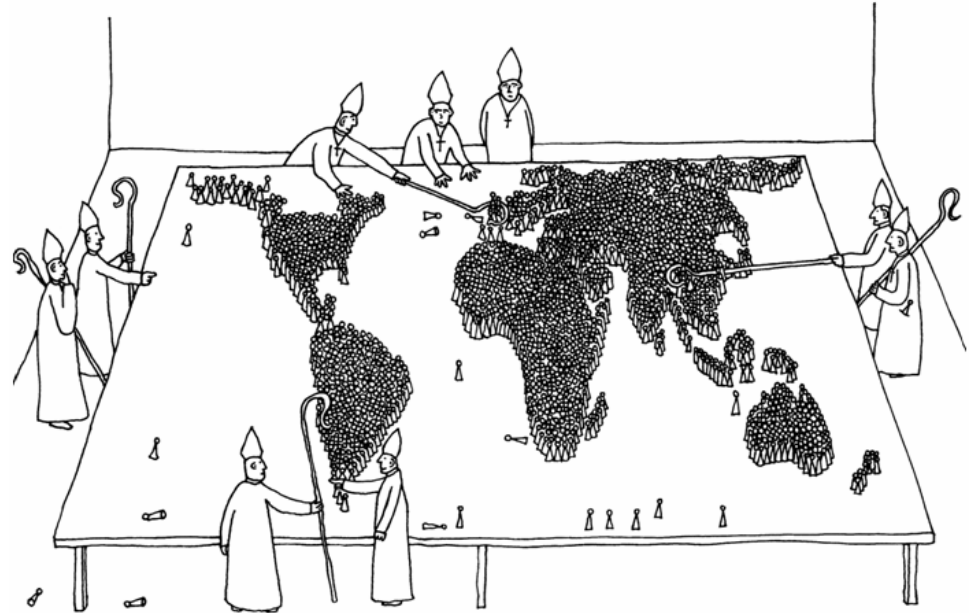


## United Benefice of Lockerley, East Dean, East Tytherley and West Tytherley
